



## **2009 Barrie Soccer Club Rep Tryouts**

### 2009 REP TEAM SELECTION IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Please take a few minutes to review the following important comments and expectations regarding Barrie Soccer Club Rep Program.

- 1) There is an additional cost for the Rep Program over and above your registration fees. The amount of the Rep Fees will be determined by the Club (approx \$400.00) and covers uniforms, league membership, referees costs, etc. There is also a Team Fee which is used for additional costs such as tournaments, equipment, clinics etc. Each team will set their Team Fees based on the number of tournaments they enter and the amount of fundraising done by the team.
- 2) The Club will appoint a Coach for each age group who will be conducting the tryouts this weekend. At the end of the tryouts, the Coach will select a group of players that will train over the winter (winter training fees will apply). A final roster for the 2009 season will be selected in March of next year. (Even though a player takes part in the winter training, doesn't necessarily mean that they will make the final roster).
- 3) It is the intention of the Club to offer two competitive teams in each age group. After tryouts are completed the Club will consult with the Coach of each age group to determine if there is sufficient interest to have a development or "B" team for that division. This decision will be based on the availability of players and qualified coaches to warrant launching a development team.
- 4) If your son/daughter is chosen to play on a rep team, he/she as well as a parent/guardian will be required to sign a code of conduct form agreeing to adhere to the rules of the Barrie Soccer Rep Program.

- 5) Equal playing time is not guaranteed in the Rep Program. The coach's decision is final as to the amount of time your son/daughter plays.
- 6) Rep teams do a lot of traveling. You must be prepared to transport your son/daughter to out of town games and tournaments.
- 7) Practices are mandatory. If your son/daughter expects to play on a Rep team, he/she must attend all scheduled practices (this may include weekends).
- 8) Rep teams, on average, enter at least 3 tournaments (some may enter 4 or 5). Some or all of these tournaments may involve overnight accommodation (in some cases two nights per tournament). Keep in mind that this is an additional cost for parents.
- 9) If you spend a good part of your summer at a family cottage (which would result in missed practices and games) or take an extra long summer vacation (one month or more), the Rep Program is not a recommended choice for your son/daughter.
- 10) There is a one time non-refundable tryout charge of \$10/player.

We believe the Rep Program will be a very positive experience for your son/daughter. However, if you feel you cannot commit to this program, please do not attend the tryouts.
