Emergency First Aid Training & Tracking

First Aid Certification

The Barrie Soccer Club has identified the safety of all players as an important priority.

Parents, in particular, with children involved in the game need to be assured that the leaders in the soccer community have the basic information and skills necessary to ensure an appropriate response to any event that might occur. Whether in practice or game play, these individuals are often called to make important assessments of situations in less than a minute.

It is highly recommended that each development/competitive team have multiple individuals certified (Head Coach, Assistant Coach, Manager or Parent) in Emergency First Aid & CPR in the event it is required at a team event.

When possible we will offer certification courses to a reasonable number of recreational team coaching staff.

To facilitate this requirement, the Barrie Soccer Club recommends that the designated person(s) for each team register and take the in-person Emergency First Aid with CPR & AED course offered through the following website:

A list of Club Employees, Staff & Volunteers who have provided proof of Emergency first Aid, CPR & AED training will be kept on file in the BSC Office. A reminder as to when recertification is required will be emailed out to each qualified member 3 months prior to their certifications expiry.

The Club will recommend the above course or direct individuals to other training sources as required and will fully/partially compensate individuals who choose to take the course subject to Board approval. At the discretion of the Board of Directors and on prior approval, for courses under \$100 full reimbursement will be provided on successful completion of the course (must provide copy of receipt and certificate of completion). For courses over \$100, reimbursement will be based on 50% of the course fee reimbursed in the month of the year in which the course was taken and 50% the following year in the same month.

The Club will maintain both an Indoor and Outdoor AED at the BSCDC and ensure that all staff is aware of the locations, appropriate use and reporting procedures and trained in their use.
