



Sponsorship Policy

The BSC is a not-for-profit organization, which means that any surplus funds generated must be put back into BSC programs. BSC is not a registered charity with Revenue Canada and therefore cannot issue charitable tax receipts.

All BSC sponsors will uphold the Club's mission, vision and values. BSC will seek sponsors who help promote community, soccer, and/or healthy lifestyles. BSC reserves the right to decline any sponsorship proposal and will not accept sponsorships from:

- Organizations whose values are contrary to those of the Club.
- Tobacco, alcohol, vaping and marijuana companies or companies that promote their sale.
- Companies that manufacture or promote the sale of weapons. •
- Companies that promote pornography.
- Companies that promote religious or political organizations that are offensive or • prejudicial to other groups.
- Companies that demean members of any group based on gender, ethnicity or sexual • orientation.
