Supplemental Player Training Policy

The Barrie Soccer Club is committed to ensuring we provide the best training and support for our players. We also understand that players have varying skill levels and needs, depending on their stage of development. To keep in line with our Club's training philosophy, standards and player development pathway, we encourage all players who seek additional training opportunities to approach their Head Coach/Lead or Technical Director first to arrange for a consultation to discuss next steps. Players and their families will be provided professional guidance where players may be placed in Club run clinics, soccer schools & soccer camps that the Barrie SC Technical Director and Staff are facilitating. In the event the player wants further technical training opportunities, or a soccer camp, clinic, school is not available, that player/parents must make the request to the Barrie Soccer Club Technical Director, who at that time will look to place the player into additional training sessions within the Club, at a pre-determined additional cost to the player.

If any of the above opportunities for in person technical supplemental training are unavailable, or the player seeks even further training in the Physical, Mental, or Tactical areas of the game the Barrie SC Technical Director will provide guidance to the player/family on where the player should attend training with any of our player development partners, and will help make the introduction.
